Dried Flowers Table Wreath

Instructions No. 2260

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 1 hour 30 Minutes

We love dried flowers - not only classically draped in a vase, but also decoratively staged as a wreath for the table. These impressive table wreaths with dried flowers are quick and easy to make. Try it out!



Quick + easy:

- 1. Paint the polystyrene rings with craft paints. We chose the colours honey yellow and reddish brown. Leave to dry.
- 2. In the meantime, shorten the dried flowers.
- 3. Poke small holes in the styrofoam rings with an awl and place the dried flowers there.

- 4. String wooden balls onto a piece of wire so that it fits around the polystyrene ring. Twist the ends of the wire together and place them around the rings.
- 5. Place a tea light glass in the middle. DONE!
