A classic Easter without a personalized Easter nest is unthinkable! Let this idea inspire you to create your own personalized DIY Easter nest as a special decoration. Or you can use the creative seagrass basket as the basis for hiding the Easter bunny's "easter eggs" on the festive day!



The basis for this springtime decoration is a seaweed basket. Take the colorful eggs and place them evenly in the basket. You can also put your own design easter eggs in the basket instead, depending on your personal taste. The eggs are the first eye-catcher and perfectly symbolize Easter.

Now add the bunny gang. Arrange the little bunnies decoratively between the eggs. The fun and cheeky bunnies add a playful touch to your decoration and bring a smile to everyone's face.

Now comes the special highlight. Use hot glue to decoratively stick a small bunny, some daisy blossoms and more eggs onto a hay mat.


Place the designed hay mat in a prominent place in your home. For example, you can choose a table or shelf as the location. Finally, place the Easter nest you have made on it.

Your new Easter decoration will bring a spring feeling into every home and make the Easter holiday something very

special.
