

Memo board with wooden burning

Step-by-step instructions: Memo board with wooden burning

Preparation of the plywood panel

To begin with, you should drill two holes in your plywood panel so that you can easily hang it up later. If this doesn't suit you, you can also attach picture frame hangers to the back to create the hanging solution of your choice.

Priming the board

Use the VBS handicraft paint to prime the plywood panel. Apply the paint evenly and allow it to dry thoroughly. A clean and even primer coat ensures a high-quality end result.

transferring the lettering

Print out our free template and transfer the desired lettering to the plywood panel using graphite paper. Alternatively, you can also design and transfer your own lettering. Make sure you leave enough space for the cork coasters.

Tracing the lettering

Use the "Easy Brush" brush and the handicraft paint to trace the lettering you have drawn. Make sure the strokes are clean and even.

Preparing the branding paint

Equip the branding pen with a thin tip and place it on the stand. Connect it to the socket so that it can heat up. The branding iron is the central tool for the fine wooden burning on your memo board.

Branding the cork coaster

Cut out the banner from the template and place it on a cork coaster. Outline it with the sublimite pen and slowly trace the lines with the heated branding pen. Repeat this process for each of the days of the week.

Attaching the cork coasters

Use VBS handicraft glue to attach the cork coasters to the plywood board and allow everything to dry thoroughly. The right adhesive will ensure that everything is stable and will last a long time.

Attaching the hanging rope

Cut a piece of cotton rope of any length. Thread the ends of the rope through the drilled holes and tie them with a knot. This allows you to hang your memo board securely and stably.

Congratulations! Your self-designed memo board with wooden burning is now ready to present your notes and memories in style. Use pins, to attach your notes and enjoy the sight of your unique work of art.
